5. New Business:

- Topic 1: A fee that our students will have to incur when traveling to Korea beginning January 1, 2025 has been waved for the SY 2024-2025. Student travelers will soon be required to apply online for an Electronic Travel Authorization (K-ETA) before travel to Korea. This will cost \$8 per person. This added cost to travel for students/families can be expensive especially when they already travel quite a bit during the season, and even more so during Far East. Will corresponding booster clubs help raise money? Money can be requested through PTO. Will this be added into Mr. Anglim's sports introduction video?
- Topic 2: Ms. Corbin-Rusnok wants to address kindness/graffiti. The graffiti was near where the school bus stop and maybe as a result of increased pedestrian traffic. Teachers can say we don't hear that type of language or see those behaviors at the high school. It has been addressed with each principal.
- Topic 3: Healthy Bodies was tentatively scheduled and then canceled due to government mandates/executive orders.
